**POSITION DESCRIPTION:** Using Theatre staff will help facilitate a safe space for practicing the ability to self-advocate, follow directions, collaborate, and to create and meet deadlines. Through role play, theatre games mask work and character study Company Members will strengthen their social and emotional awareness. Staff are also responsible for assisting with the development and running of activities that provide skill reinforcement in areas that may include: socialization, personal hygiene, communication, exercise, interpersonal skills/relationships, reading and language development, anger management/relaxation, civic awareness and self determination. Activities may be provided at the Center or in the community. Staff will assist participants in completing any programmatic needs as stated in the individual's ISP. Staff responsibilities will include completion of necessary documentation and providing supervision of the participants in the program as stated in their ISP. Staff may need to provide hands-on supervision of personal hygiene and/or toileting needs. Staff will need to understand and demonstrate the approach of person-centered planning. This is a Part-Time position, working 20 hours per week; with vacation and sick time accrued on hours worked. Schedule will include off-hour events in the evening or on weekends.
